### Principal's Report – Mr Hull

- Parent volunteers are needed for the committee to determine how to spend the \$50,000 received from Dollar General
  - o Technology devices & books will (generally) be funded by the \$50,000
- TM added 2 new staff members: one Life Skills Para and one 5<sup>th</sup> grade reading and math helper
- Congress school funding is trending down. "Allowable Growth" is the terminology used to determine the school budget increase, which is spent from the savings account.
  - Encourage parents and anyone else to petition Iowa Senator or Governor to increase the Allowable Growth to 4% and to apply a cap to transportation spending
